DAY – 1 WELCOME TO BAKU

- ❖ Arrival at Airport.
- ❖ Transfer from Airport to Hotel

DAY – 2 BAKU CITY TOUR + PANAROMIC TOUR

- ❖ Breakfast in Hotel
- ❖ 10:00 Tour starts with the visit to the charming example of modern architecture - **The Heydar Aliyev Center**— a 57,500 m2 building complex in Baku, Azerbaijan designed by Iraqi-British architect Zaha Hadid and noted for its distinctive architecture and flowing, curved style that eschews sharp angles. The center is named after Heydar Aliyev, the first secretary of Soviet Azerbaijan from 1969 to 1982, and president of Azerbaijan Republic from October 1993 to October 2003. (Photo shoot outside)
- ❖ 13:00 lunch
- ❖ 17:00 Assembly at lobby. Start tour. Visit to Highland Park-Alley of Martyrs, The National Assembly- also transliterated as Milli Majlis, Flame towers-the tallest skyscraper in Baku.
- ❖ Walking through Baku Boulevard which stretches along a south-facing bay on the Caspian Sea. It traditionally starts at Freedom Square continuing west to the Old City and beyond. Since 2012, the Yeni Bulvar (New Boulevard) has virtually doubled the length to 3.75 km.
- ❖ Later experience the happening street **of Nizami Street** known for Shopping. The Street's history could be traced back to Baku's town-planning project of 1864. The street runs through the city's downtown from west to east. It begins from Abdulla Shaig Street, in mountainous part of the city and ends at railroad bed on Sabit Orujov Street, near a monument to Shah Ismail Khatai in "Black City".

- ❖ Free time – can explore night activities at you own
- ❖ Overnight in hotel

DAY – 3 FLAME TOUR + OLD CITY TOUR

- ❖ Breakfast in Hotel
- ❖ 10:00 Assembly at hotel lobby. Tour starts with **Ateshgah** (Fire Worshippers Temple)
- ❖ Based on Persian and Indian inscriptions, the temple was used as a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship. "Atash" is the Persian word for fire. The pentagonal complex, which has a courtyard surrounded by cells for monks and a tetra pillar-altar in the middle, was built during the 17th and 18th centuries. It was abandoned in the late 19th century, probably due to the dwindling of the Indian population in the area. The natural "eternal flame" went out in 1969, after nearly a century of exploitation of petroleum and gas in the area, but is now lit by gas piped from the nearby city
- ❖ Trip to "Fire Mountain" - "**Yanardag**" – a mountain on Abs heron peninsula, 25 km from north of Baku. Literally, word "Yanardag" means "Blazing Mountain". Blazing bodies of flame dance on stones and floor. Yanar dag is a natural gas fire which blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula on the Caspian Sea near Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, which itself is known as the "land of fire."
- ❖ 13:00 Lunch
- ❖ 10:00 Our tour program starts with **Old City or Inner City** is the historical core of Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. The Old City is the most ancient part of Baku, which is surrounded by walls were well protected. In 2007, the Old City had a population of about 3000 people. In December 2000, the Old City of Baku, including the **Palace of the Shirvanshahs** and **Maiden Tower**, became the first location in Azerbaijan to be classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO (walking tour)
- ❖ 20:00 Transfer for dinner at Indian restaurant at 2000 hrs
- ❖ Transfer to hotel at 2230 hrs
- ❖ Free time – can explore night activities at you own
- ❖ Overnight in hotel
- ❖ Meals: Breakfast+ Lunch + Dinner

DAY – 4 GOBUSTAN + SHOPPING TOUR

- ❖ Breakfast at the hotel
- ❖ 10:00 Tour starts with Qobustan which is best known for being the home to the famous rock petroglyphs. The area has been settled since the 8th millennium BC. It is known for hosting thousands of rock engravings spread over 100 square km depicting hunting scenes, people, ships, constellations and animals. Its oldest petroglyphs date from the 12th century BC. In 2007, UNESCO included the 'Gobustan Rock Art Cultural Landscape' in the World Heritage list.
- ❖ Visit to the Bibi – Heybat Mosque– historical mosque in Baku, Azerbaijan. The existing structure, built in the 1990s, is a recreation of the mosque with the same name built in the 13th century by Shirvanshah Farrukhzad II Ibn Ahsitan II
- ❖ 14:00 lunch
- ❖ 16:00 Start Shopping tour with Local Sweet Shop, Azerbaijan Brand: Aliahmad'S
- ❖ Proceed to Local vine and alcoholic drinks shop
- ❖ Continue with "Xurcun" dry fruits and sweets shop
- ❖ Genclik Mall: - located in 10 minutes' distance form city center with taxi. Genclik mall is the biggest Mall in Baku and contains over 80 stores, big bowling halls, the biggest movie halls, 3D cinema, Playground for children, Bravo supermarket, VIP restaurants, food courts
- ❖ 20:00 dinner
- ❖ Free time – can explore night activities at you own
- ❖ overnight in hotel
- ❖ Meals: Breakfast + Lunch + Dinner

DAY – 5 DAY AT LEISURE + DEPARTURE

- ❖ Breakfast in Hotel
- ❖ 12:00 Check out Hotel.
- ❖ Day free for shopping
- ❖ Meals: Breakfast + Lunch + dinner
- ❖ Transfer to airport at 2200hrs to catch flight back home.

- Clients are requested to read the above cancellation policy before confirming the tour.
- If the payment not made in time, the tour can be cancelled or the cost of the tour may be revised.
- The above cancellation charges will be charged even if the tour cancel because of visa delay/rejected because of any reason and/or any medical reason also.
- Since non-refundable cost of package tour paid in advance to reserve the services for the group, clients are requested to read the above before confirming the tour. Passengers joining the tour means they have read the cancellation policy and have accepted the same
- The above cancellation charges are applicable even if the cancellation is because of delay/refusal of visa by the embassy/high commission because of an reason

Remarks

- The cost of foreign exchange component will be collected in Indian Rupees as per forex card rate (Rate on xe.com + 1 INR) as on date of full and final payment from the proceed of foreign Exchange purchased from an authorized dealer under BTQ
- GST as per applicable rate (5% for package tour) & TCS will be applicable on the Total Package Cost (unless otherwise mentioned in quotation).
- 5% TCS to be charged for all passengers. In case a passenger does not provide PAN card, 10% TCS will be charged. For cases like children where PAN card is not available, PAN card of parents will be applicable. Applicable TCS rate will be 20% w.e.f. 1st October, 2023 on billing of more than INR 7 Lakh.
- The decision to grant visa is taken solely by Embassy/High Commission of the respective country. Dewan Travels Pvt Ltd is not responsible in case visa is delayed/not granted to the client for any reason.
- Passengers are requested to check COVID protocol of destination before travelling.
